Nell’ottobre 1963 il settimanale del Partito comunista italiano “Rinascita” pubblicava un lungo articolo di Umberto Eco “sui problemi della cultura di opposizione”. Quel saggio - per la precoce notorietà del giovane intellettuale, l’introduzione di temi inediti, e la capacità di Eco di tenere insieme “alto” e “basso”, nonché di spaziare in campi tra loro molto diversi - costituì una provocazione feconda per la cultura di sinistra, da cui nacque un dibattito destinato a ridiscutere lo stesso ruolo dell’intellettuale engagé, che coinvolse tra gli altri Rossana Rossanda, Edoardo Sanguineti, il filosofo Louis Althusser.
