Urban Landscapes - Massimo Sargolini 2012-12-15

Today, more than 50% of the world's population lives in cities and is subject to particular environmental and economic impacts against the backdrop of an evolving planetary crisis. This book explores the intimate relationship between the quality of life of city dwellers and the quality of urban landscapes, including those regenerated through green spaces and environmental networks. Starting from the concept of "landscape" as defined by the European Landscape Convention (i.e. "an area, perceived by people, whose character is the result of the action and interaction of natural and/or human factors"), it expands upon, in particular, the interactions between the different biotic and abiotic components that contribute to the quality of the landscape and the environment. In the first part of the book, the author examines fundamental concepts and discusses a variety of relevant topics, such as the city under transformation, waste spaces,

smart communities, regeneration programs, the role of environmental networks, and new instruments for decision making. The second part is devoted to a case study of the Italian Adriatic city that highlights the need for interdisciplinary interaction among researchers in apparently disparate fields, including ecology, forest botany, chemistry, biology, geology, sociology, economics, architecture, and engineering.

Organizing for Digital Innovation - Alessandra Lazazzara 2018-06-29

This book presents a collection of research papers exploring the human side of digital innovation management, with a specific focus on what people say and share on social media, how they respond to the introduction of specific IT tools, and how digital innovations are impacting sustainability and inclusion. The overall spread of digital and technological advances is enhanced or hampered by people's skills, behaviors and attitudes. The book spans a scientific research program elegantly developed by Roberto Camagni, an eminent regional scientist, who has offered ground-breaking ideas in regional and urban economics throughout his academic career. In addition to bringing together a selection of Professor Camagni's most influential works, the book presents syntheses and interpretations of his ideas by

respected colleagues and by his students. A vast amount of theories and models have been developed since the official recognition of regional economics as a distinct branch of economics. In particular, this book focuses on logical and theoretical linkages between different theories and models: both macro and microeconomic; neoclassical and Keynesian. The evolution of theoretical approaches in regional economics is dealt in the book through the evolution of the concept of space: from physical space, which characterizes location theory,

to uniform space (typical of neoclassical and Keynesian approaches) to diversified-relational space (embedded in local districts and milieu approaches, as well as in the theory of learning regions) to diversified stylised space (as exemplified by the new economic geography and dynamic neoclassical approaches).

Il tema della crescita "intorno" alla città, altrove dibattuto già a partire dal dopoguerra come una delle componenti primarie dei processi di sviluppo urbano, in Italia è divenuto argomento centrale del dibattito architettonico e urbanistico a partire dagli anni Ottanta, con l'esplosione delle contraddizioni emerse con la crescita della città illegale, che ha reso non più differibile la presa di coscienza sulla necessità di ricucire le diverse parti della città, altrimenti disomogeneamente contrapposte. Il problema della

“convivenza” tra città compatta e città diffusa (legittima o spontanea) è alla base del testo e pone interrogativi che vanno oltre il campo disciplinare dell'urbanistica, fino ad investire aspetti più propriamente legati alle politiche economico finanziarie del governo del territorio. Maria Rita Schirru, architetto e ingegnere, ha conseguito il Dottorato di ricerca in Pianificazione Territoriale e Urbana nel 2010. Docente a contratto nell'anno accademico 2010-2011 presso la Facoltà di Architettura “Valle Giulia” della “Sapienza” Università di Roma, negli anni 2006-2008 è stata consulente di Risorse per Roma spa per attività di supporto alle procedure concorsuali per la realizzazione di opere pubbliche all'interno di progetti di riassetto urbano e programmi di valorizzazione banditi dal Comune di Roma. Attualmente è membro della Struttura tecnica di missione, presso il Ministero delle Infrastrutture e dei Trasporti, in qualità di esperto nel campo della pianificazione territoriale

e urbana, per l'esame delle questioni tecnico-ingegneristiche connesse agli interventi di interesse nazionale previsti dalla “legge Obiettivo” del 2001. Svolge attività di consulenza per il Comune di Roma, Dipartimento Sviluppo delle Infrastrutture e Manutenzione Urbana, per il recupero delle periferie. È membro della Commissione Centrale di Vigilanza per l'edilizia popolare ed economica, presso il Ministero delle Infrastrutture e dei Trasporti.

This book is the result of a three day workshop on "Evaluation in theory and practice in spatial planning" held in Ramsey Hall, University College London, in September 1996. Some 30 people from 8 different countries attended

and 20 papers were presented. The majority of them now form the basis for this book. This occasion was the third on the topic, the two preceding having taken place in Umea in June 1992 and in Bari in 1994. Following these three meetings, we can now say that this small, industrious, international family really enjoy meeting up from time to time at each others places, in the presence of older members and new children, each one presenting his/her own recent experiences. It particularly enjoys exchanging views and arguing about the current state and the future of evaluation in spatial planning (all families have their vices ...). It is also pleasing to see these experiences and discussions resulting in a book for those who could not attend and for the broader clan in the field.
