Extinction - Ashley Dawson 2016-08-01

Some thousands of years ago, the world was home to an immense variety of large mammals. From woolly mammoths and saber-toothed tigers to giant ground sloths and armadillos the size of automobiles, these spectacular creatures roamed freely. Then human beings arrived. Devouring their way down the food chain as they spread across the planet, they began a process of voracious extinction that has continued to the present. Headlines today are made by the existential threat confronting remaining large animals such as rhinos and pandas. But the devastation summoned by humans extends to humbler realms of creatures including beetles, bats and butterflies. By any measure, the privatisation and liberalisation of the UK energy industry was an enormous success. And yet the public are not convinced. As energy expert Carlo Stagnaro shows in this important book, the re-regulation of the market in the UK, together with policy developed at the EU level, has undermined all the important developments of the 1990s and early 2000s. The result has not only been poorer outcomes in the energy market but a very inefficient approach to reduce carbon dioxide emissions. The EU has also only been partially successful in promoting liberalisation and competition in electricity markets and the time is ripe for change. The author shows how the EU must learn the lessons from the UK's successful recent past - and the UK must re-learn them. Therein lies the route to a competitive energy market that serves the ends of consumers rather than the ends of politicians and other interest groups.

Sotto la spinta della retorica più aggressiva della nuova amministrazione degli Stati Uniti, il 2017 ha messo allo scoperto il peso sempre crescente che la tradizionale dinamica tra le grandi potenze sta riacquistando anche nel contesto internazionale del XXI secolo. Contrariamente alle

previsioni e alle retoriche più ottimistiche del primo dopoguerra fredda, il “gioco tra grandi” ha riconquistato il centro della scena, spinto in parte dalla crescita e dalla rinnovata assertività di potenziali competitori globali degli Stati Uniti quali la Russia e la Cina, in parte dalla perdurante crisi del tessuto multilaterale della convivenza internazionale e, in parte ancora maggiore, dalla scomposizione del sistema regionale in arene sempre più autonome, all'interno delle quali cresce anche il peso delle rispettive grandi potenze locali. Il Rapporto ISPI 2018 si interroga su questo mutamento, controbilanciato solo in parte dalle buone notizie che, nel corso dell'ultimo anno, sono venute dall'economia internazionale. La prima parte del volume è dedicata al contesto globale, la seconda si domanda quale posto possa occupare l'Europa in un “mondo di grandi”, mentre la terza si rivolge come di consueto alla politica estera italiana.

È possibile tracciare in un'unica, serrata narrazione la «storia materiale» dell'universo dal big bang all'evoluzione della coscienza di Homo sapiens? Sì, lo è, se al compito - ambizioso ai limiti dell'azzardo - provvede uno scienziato come Jim Baggott, con il suo approccio al contempo rigoroso e affascinante. Ricorrendo alle più recenti acquisizioni di tutte le discipline funzionali all'impresa - astrofisica e biologia evoluzionistica, cosmologia e genetica -, Baggott risale infatti, in puntuale successione cronologica, a tante «origini» correlate e distinte, ognuna inquadrata come una sequenza chiave: dalla formazione dello spaziotempo e della massa-energia, pochi istanti dopo il big bang, all'apparizione della luce, dalla genesi delle galassie fino al progressivo delinearci della «nostra» porzione di universo con la nascita del sistema solare e della Terra. Nell'ambiente caldo e umido di quest'ultima si creeranno le condizioni per l'origine forse più misteriosa e imperscrutabile, quella della vita. Il manifestarsi dei primi organismi terrestri unicellulari, circa quattro miliardi di anni fa, innesca quel processo evolutivo che culminerà nell'emersione di Homo sapiens: un percorso lungo e tormentato, «interrotto a più riprese dalle imprevedibili brutalità del caso» - ere glaciali, eruzioni vulcaniche, impatti con

asteroidi -, responsabili di periodiche estinzioni di massa. Non c'è romanzo di avventura più imprevedibile.

The refreshed insights into early-imperial Roman historiography this book offers are linked to a recent discovery. In the spring of 2014, the binders of the archive of Robert Marichal were dusted off by the ERC funded project PLATINUM (ERC-StG 2014 n°636983) in response to Tiziano Dorandi's recollections of a series of unpublished notes on Latin texts on papyrus. Among these was an in-progress edition of the Latin rolls from Herculaneum, together with Marichal's intuition that one of them had to be ascribed to a certain 'Annaeus Seneca'. PLATINUM followed the unpublished intuition by Robert Marichal as one path of investigation in its own research and work. Working on the Latin P.Herc. 1067 led to confirm Marichal's intuitions and to go beyond it: P.Herc. 1067 is the only extant direct witness to Seneca the Elder's *Historiae*. Bringing a new and important chapter of Latin literature arise out of a charred papyrus is significant. The present volume is made up of two complementary sections, each of which contains seven contributions. They are in close dialogue with each other, as looking at the same literary matter from several points of view yields undeniable advantages and represents an innovative and fruitful step in Latin literary criticism. These two sections express the two different but interlinked axes along which the contributions were developed. On one side, the focus is on the starting point of the debate, namely the discovery of the papyrus roll transmitting the *Historiae* of Seneca the Elder and how such a discovery

can be integrated with prior knowledge about this historiographical work. On the other side, there is a broader view on early-imperial Roman historiography, to which the new perspectives opened by the rediscovery of Seneca the Elder's *Historiae* greatly contribute.
