Above Misminay, the sky also is so divided by the alternation of the two axes of the Milky Way passing through the zenith.

This mirror-image quadripartition of terrestrial and celestial spheres is such that a point within one of the quarters of the earth is related to a point within the corresponding celestial quarter. The transition between the earth and the sky occurs at the horizon, where sacred mountains are related to topographic and celestial features. Based on fieldwork in Misminay, Peru, Gary Urton details a cosmology in which the Milky Way is central. This is the first study that provides a description and analysis of the astronomical and cosmological system in a contemporary community in

the Americas. Separate chapters take up the sun, the moon, meteorological phenomena, the stars, and the planets. Star-to-star constellations, the "animal" dark-cloud constellations that cut through the Milky Way, and certain twilight- and midnight-zenith stars are analyzed in terms of their spatial and temporal integration within an indigenous cosmological framework. Urton breaks new ground by demonstrating the indigenous merging of such forms of "precise knowledge" as astronomy, meteorology, agriculture, and the correlation of astronomical and biological cycles within a single calendar system. More than sixty diagrams clarify this Quechua system of astronomy and relate it to more familiar principles of Western astronomy and cosmology.

Full Employment in a Free Society (Works of William H. Beveridge) - William H. Beveridge 2014-11-27

Beveridge defined full employment as a state where there are slightly more vacant jobs than there are available workers, or not more than 3% of the total workforce. This book discusses how this goal

might be achieved, beginning with the thesis that because individual employers are not capable of creating full employment, it must be the responsibility of the state. Beveridge claimed that the upward pressure on wages, due to the increased bargaining strength of labour, would be eased by rising productivity, and kept in check by a system of wage arbitration. The cooperation of workers would be secured by the common interest in the ideal of full employment. Alternative measures for achieving full employment included Keynesian-style fiscal regulation, direct control of manpower, and state control of the means of production. The impetus behind Beveridge's thinking was social justice and the creation of an ideal new society after the war. The book was written in the context of an economy which would have to transfer from wartime direction to peace time. It was then updated in 1960, following a decade where the average unemployment rate in Britain

was in fact nearly 1.5%.

Gli atleti azzurri non vennero inizialmente coinvolti nella ripresa delle attività e in alcune federazioni internazionali si arrivò persino all'esclusione o alla sospensione dell'Italia. Partendo dall'assunto che, in virtù della sua elevata visibilità, lo sport, pur essendo un fenomeno periferico e non vitale del sistema politico internazionale, rappresenta tanto una variabile quanto uno strumento di politica estera, questo lavoro mira a rispondere a una serie di interrogativi. Perché, al contrario di Germania e Giappone, l'Italia poté partecipare alle Olimpiadi del

1948? In quali proporzioni l'eredità del fascismo e la guerra fredda influenzarono la ripresa internazionale dello sport italiano? In che modo i primi governi repubblicani utilizzarono lo sport come strumento di politica estera? E come invece le istituzioni sportive e gli atleti si allinearono a quest'ultima? Dopo aver analizzato quali furono gli attori e le istituzioni del sistema sportivo italiano e internazionale del decennio 1943-1953, il volume ripercorre cronologicamente il cammino dello sport azzurro dalla quarantena dell'immediato dopoguerra alle assegnazioni olimpiche di Cortina 1956 e di Roma 1960. Particolare attenzione è dedicata alla ripresa dei rapporti sportivi bilaterali e alla rilegittimazione italiana presso il Comitato Olimpico Internazionale e le singole federazioni. Il volume è inoltre arricchito da alcuni casi di studio in cui da un lato si mette in luce come la politica internazionale (dalla guerra fredda alla formazione del

Il Mausoleo delle Fosse Ardeatine è il primo monumento a non essere concepito come oggetto da contemplare ma come percorso «da agire», per far rivivere il tragitto seguito dalle vittime; le forme - naturali, architettoniche e artistiche - non sono intese come stazioni di arrivo, ma come tappe intermedie di un circuito continuo. Da Roma ci spostiamo a Berlino, per raccontare il memoriale progettato da Peter Eisenman: una gigantesca griglia deformata e sbilenca che registra il passaggio dal

monumento come percorso al monumento come brano di città. Se il «contro-monumento», nella versione di Jochen Gerz, prevede già nella concezione la sua sparizione, spetta alle «pietre d'inciampo» ideate da Gunter Demnig l'intuizione del «memoriale diffuso» dedicato a tutti i deportati: discreto, centrifugo, anti-gerarchico e in progress, è un enorme mosaico della memoria europea le cui tessere sono le decine di migliaia di sampietrini collocati davanti alle abitazioni dei deportati, che restituiscono loro dignità di persone e un luogo dove ricordarli. Senza la pretesa di essere esaustivo o imparziale, questo studio si basa sulla convinzione che, in tema di memoria, la testimonianza artistica, o il contenitore architettonico, non sono mai indifferenti, né tantomeno neutrali
